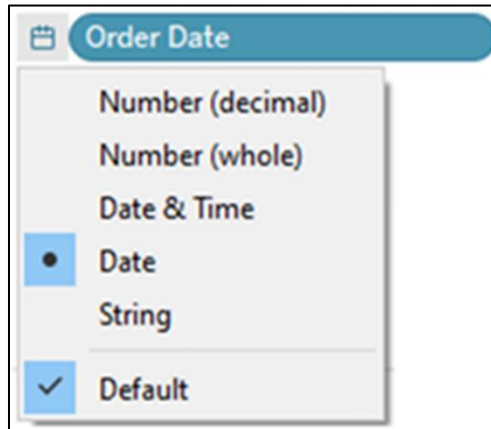


Figure 2.2: Changing the data type.

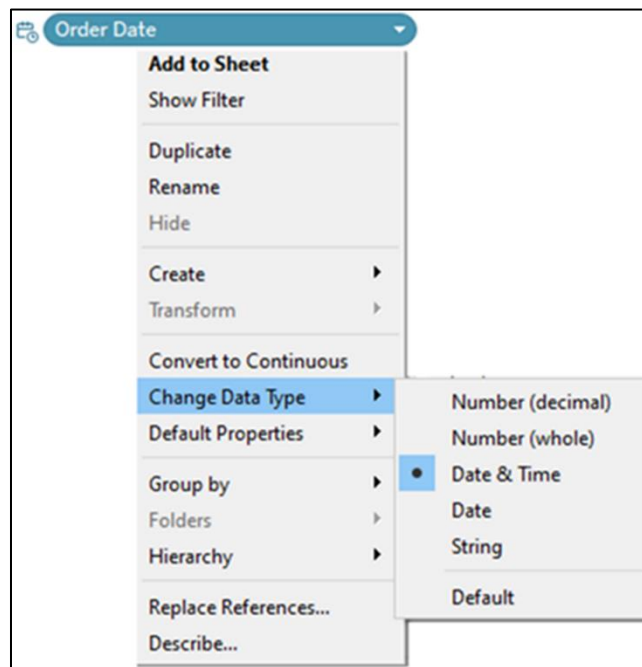


Figure 2.3: Changing the data type - alternative way.

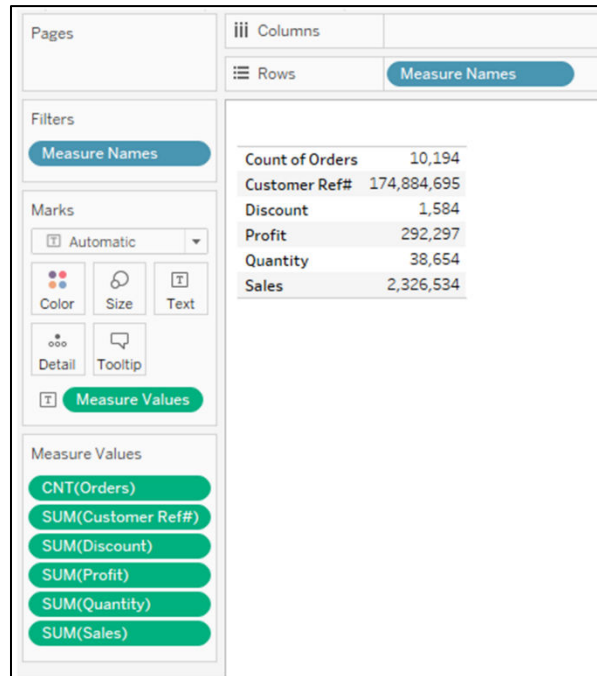


Figure 2.4 Using Measure Names and Measure Values.

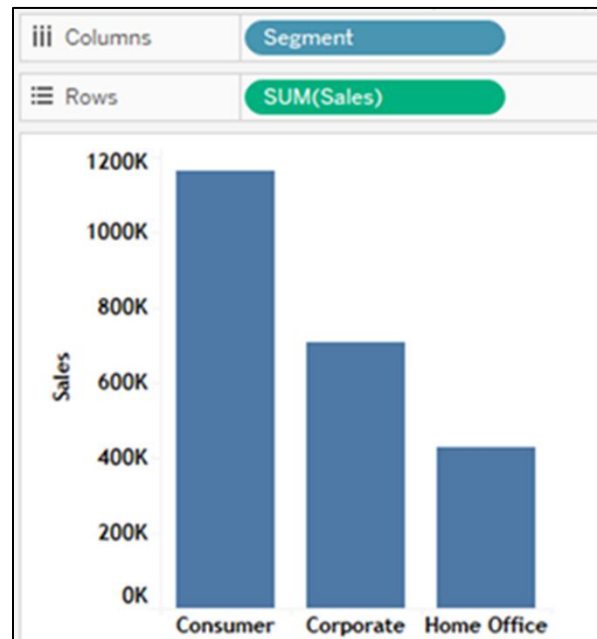


Figure 2.5 Dimensions as Labels and Measures as axis.

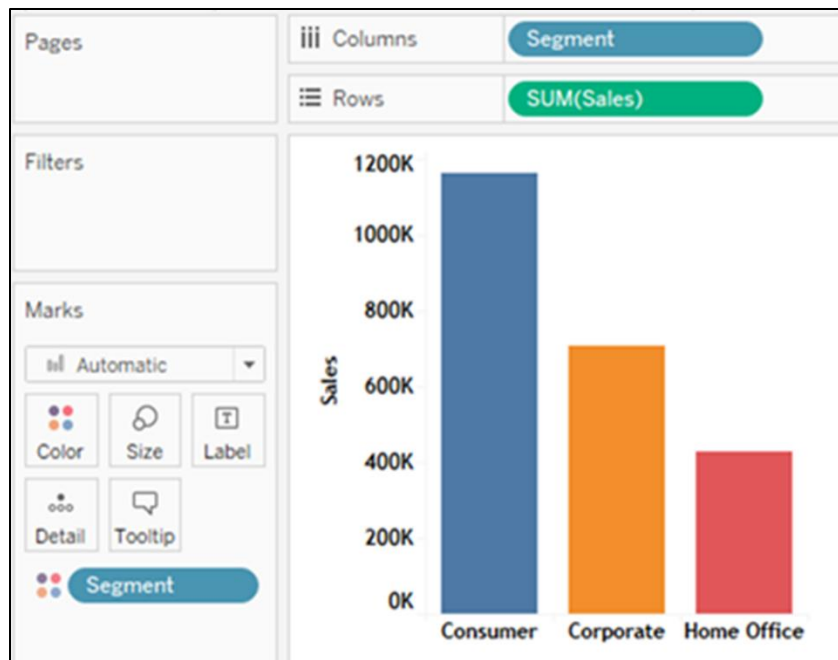


Figure 2.6: Dimension placed on color.

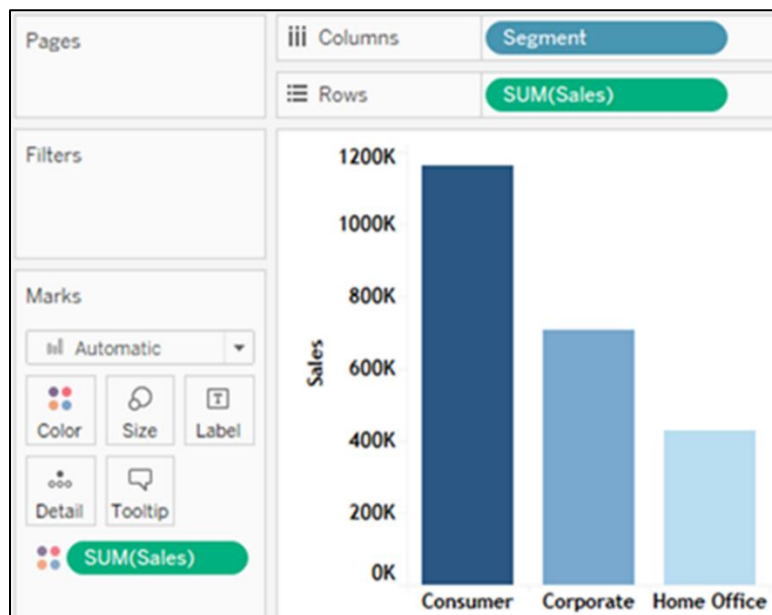


Figure 2.7: Measure placed on color.

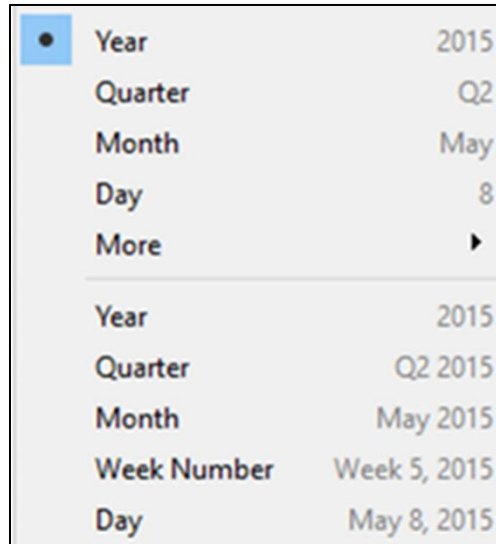


Figure 2.9: Date options from the context menu.

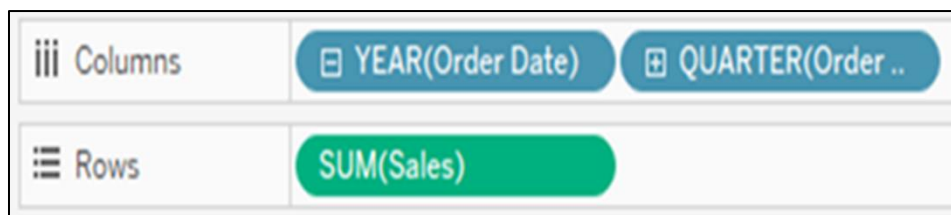


Figure 2.10: Year drill down to Quarter.

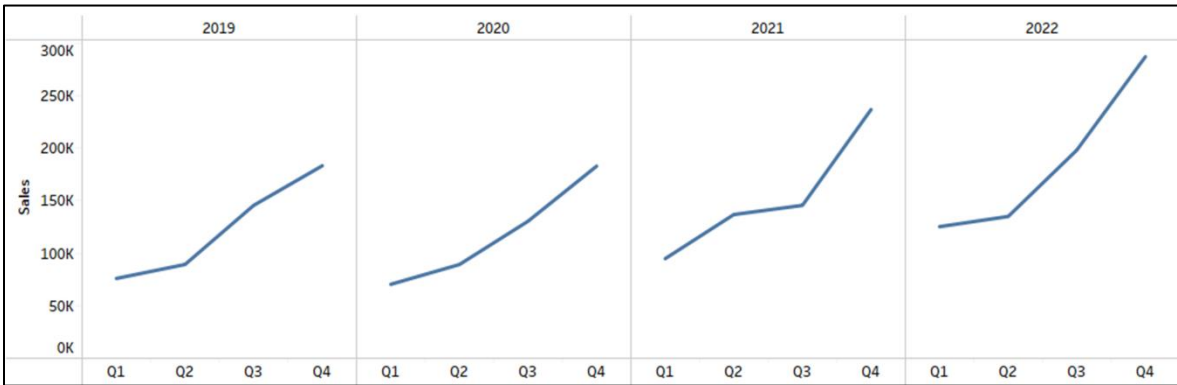


Figure 2.11: Line chart with broken lines for Quarter.

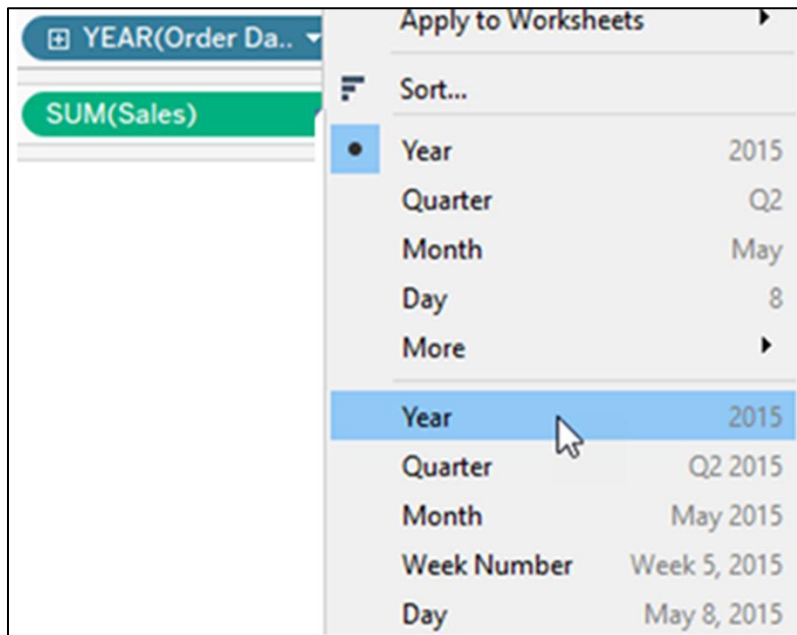


Figure 2.12: Selecting continuous Year option.

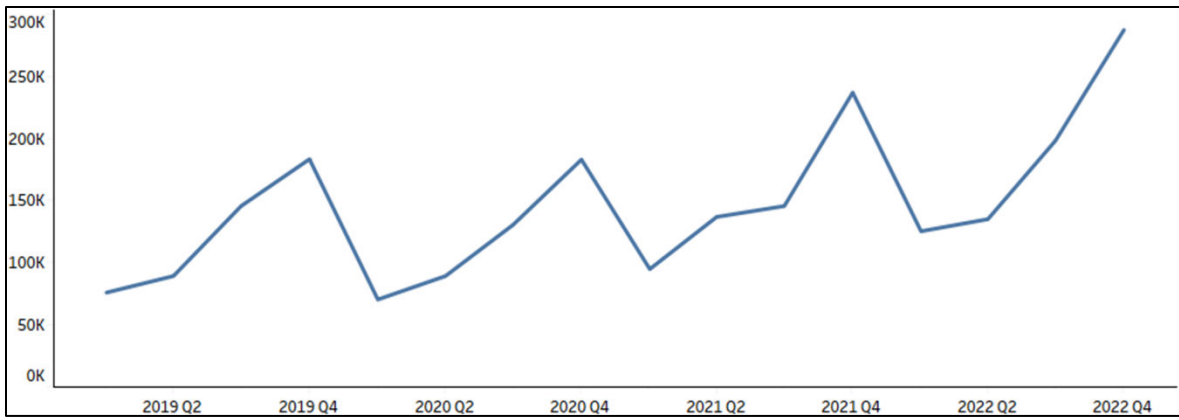


Figure 2.13: Line chart with continuous lines for Quarter for each year.

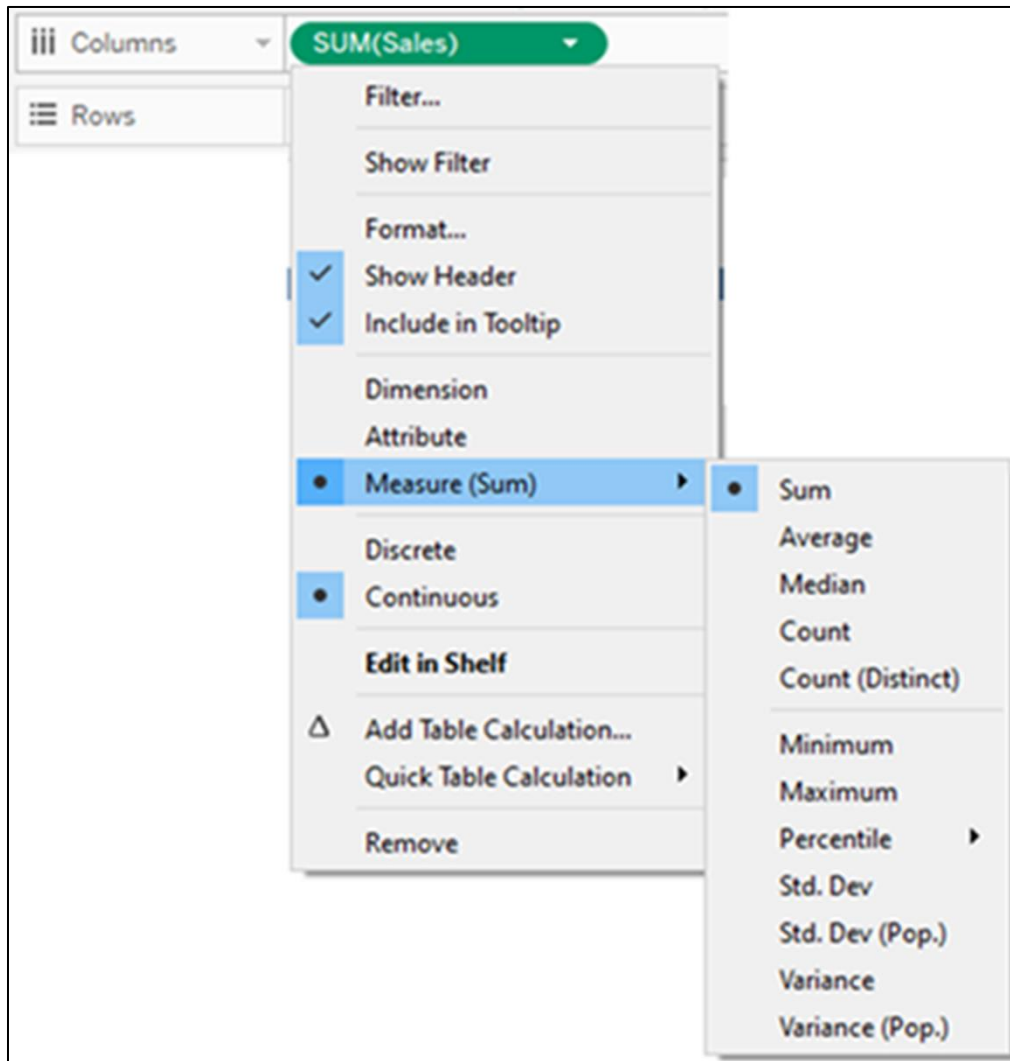


Figure 2.14: Aggregations available on the Measure.

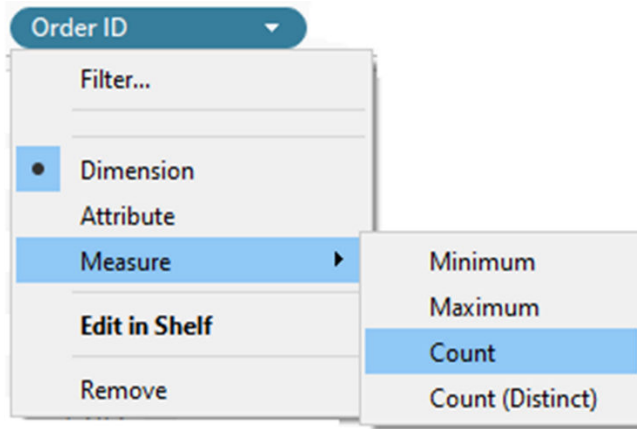


Figure 2.15: Aggregations available on the Dimension.

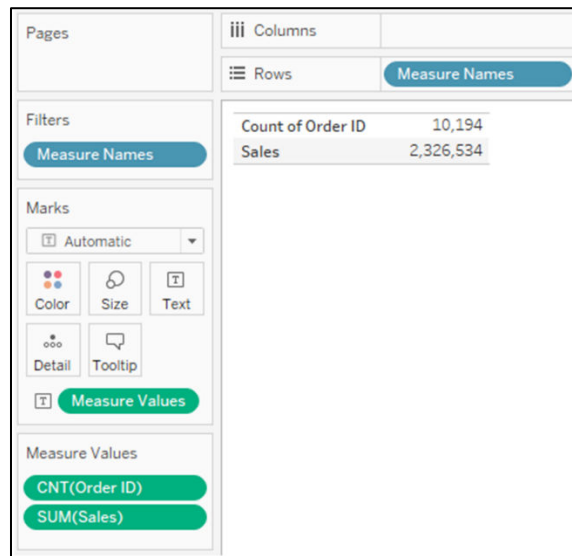


Figure 2.16: Count of Order ID and Sales.
